Sweating the Small Stuff for Systems Change

Dr Linda Holbeche is a consultant, developer, researcher and author in the fields of HR, Leadership, Strategy and Change. Previously in Director roles at the CIPD, at the Work Foundation and at Roffey Park, Linda is Visiting Professor at five UK universities; a member of several advisory boards and a Fellow of the Institute for Employment Studies and of Roffey Park. She edits Croner's Strategic Briefings series and recent books include: *The Agile Organization: how to build an innovative, sustainable and resilient business* (2015, Kogan Page); *Organization Development, a Practitioner's Guide for OD and HR, 2nd Edition* (2015, with Dr Mee-Yan Cheung-Judge, Kogan-Page); *Engaged: Unleashing the Potential of Your Organisation Through Employee Engagement*, (2012, with Geoffrey Matthews, Wiley/Jossey-Bass); and *People and Organizational Development* (2012, co-edited with Prof H. Francis and M. Reddington, CIPD)

The question of whether you can deliberately shift organisational cultures in a specific direction has been debated for years. After all cultures are developing all the time and many institutional culture change efforts end in failure. This session will explore systemic barriers to compassionate care, and how sweating the small stuff can bring about sustainable shifts towards more compassionate practice.
